BALASORE: GEOGRAPHICAL PROFILE


- Balasore District covers an area of **3634 sq kms**. The District is surrounded by Medinipur District of West Bengal in its northern side, Bay of Bengal in its east, Bhadrak District in its south and Mayurbhanj and Kendujhar Districts lies on its western side. The District is located at 20.48 to 21.59 North Latitude and 86.16 to 87.29 east Longitude.
- Balasore is one of the coastal Districts of Odisha, having a coastline of **137kms**. It lies on the northern most part of the state. It was a part of the ancient Kalinga which later became a territory of Toshal or Utkal. Balasore as a separate District was created in October 1828. Originally it was in Bengal presidency.
- This district consists of two subdivisions namely **Balasore** and **Nilgiri**. There are **12** Tahasils for **12** Blocks of the district. Balasore is the main town of the district and is also its centre of economic growth.
- The beautiful sea beaches and temples attract local and national tourists to the district **Chandipur, Talasari, Chawmukh, Kashaphal** sea beaches are the famous. Temples like **Panchalingeswar, Khirochora Gopinath, Langaleswar, Laxmannath, Chandaneswar, Maninageswar** are the points of attraction.

POSTAL BALLOT PRINTING

Preparations:

1. **Printer:** Shri Durga Printing Press, Sahadevkhunta ,Balasore
2. AROs for Postal ballot Printing have been appointed
3. 712 nos of Form 12-D have been received from AVSC and AVPD as on 12.05.2024 for Home voting
4. All polling personnel and other Electors engaged in election duty (i.e SO, Driver, Conductor etc.)have been provided Form 12. 12726 nos. Form 12 have been collected as on 14.05. 2024.
5. Additional AROs have been identified for Counting of Postal Ballot.
6. Each AC will have 5 tables for PB Counting, except Balasore & Jaleswar AC. Each of these two ACs will have 4 Tables each.
7. 14 tables have been identified for counting of PB for 6 – Balasore PC
8. Counting Hall layout has been submitted for Approval.

Postal Ballot Planning w.r.t Home Voting Preparation

1. In order to complete Home Voting in a timely manner , 10 teams have been formed for each AC/AS.
2. Each team will cover 20 households per day, as such 200 households (Voters) can be covered in a day.
3. Two rounds of home voting have been planned @ 2 days per round. The second round is meant to visit only the absentees voters who will be absent in the first round.

Facilities for PWD Voters

- Provision of Ramps has been made in all the polling Stations
- Provision of Wheel Chair in all the polling Stations
- Volunteers identified for all the polling stations to help the PWD voters
- Vehicles to be engaged to facilitate pick and drop facility for the PWD voters to reach at Booths
