

Integrated Tribal Development Agency (ITDA), Nilgiri invites sealed Expressions of Interest (EOI) from eligible and reputed firms/organizations/registered suppliers/Empanelled Agencies of the Animal Resources Development Department, preferably based in Balasore district, possessing a valid and up-to-date GST registration, for the procurement and supply of goats and allied inputs under the Mukhyamantri Janajati Jeevika Mission (MMJJM) for tribal beneficiaries of Nilgiri Sub-Division (covering one block). The detailed technical specifications, scope of work, and terms and conditions are provided in the EOI document.

Bidders downloading the document shall submit the same along with a non-refundable cost of EOI document in the form of a Demand Draft (DD) at the time of submission.

Expression of Interest (EOI) for participating in the supply of Goat and allied items under the Scheme Mukhyamantri Janajati Jeevika Mission (MMJJM) of ITDA, Nilgiri

Goats are multi-functional animal and plays a significant role in the economy and nutrition of landless, small and marginal tribal farmers in the state. Goat rearing is an enterprise which has been practiced by a large section of population in rural areas. Goat can efficiently survive on available shrubs and trees in adverse harsh environment in low fertility lands where no other crop can be grown. In pastoral and agricultural subsistence societies in Odisha, Goat are kept as a source of additional income and as an insurance against disaster. They are also used in ceremonial feastings and for the payment of social dues. In addition to this, Goat have religious and ritualistic importance in many societies.

1. Objectives

1. With the objective of employment generation, entrepreneurship development, increase in per animal productivity and thus targeting increased production of meat, goat milk augmenting local needs in the District and providing rich source of protein to the child for a healthy tomorrow, and at the same time provide sustainable livelihood to ST families, the ITDA, Nilgiri intends to invest on Goat Farming in cluster location under MMJJM project area. The concept of the Scheme is to develop the entrepreneurs in order to create the forward and backward linkage for the produce available at the unorganized sector and to link with the organized sector.
2. The scheme has been formulated keeping in mind certain assumptions.
  - a) That in past years the ITDA has supported farmers in the form of subsidy whether in Dairy, Goatary or Poultry farming, but the overall impact has not yielded much result.
  - b) That even though farmers are now aware of the potential of Goat farming, yet the courage to venture into this activity is not there due to lack of financial resources etc.
  - c) The initial investment needed for Goat farming is low. Due to small body size and docile nature, housing requirements and management problems with goats are less. Goats are prolific breeders and achieve sexual maturity at the age of 10-12 months gestation period in goats is short and at the age of 16-17 months it starts giving milk. Twinning is very common and triplets and quadruplets are rare. In drought prone areas risk of goat farming is very much less as compared to other livestock species. Unlike large animals in commercial farm conditions both male and female goats have equal value. Goats are ideal for mixed species grazing. The animal can thrive well on wide variety of thorny bushes, weeds, crop residues, agricultural by- products unsuitable for human consumption. Under proper management, goats can improve and maintain grazing land and reduce bush encroachment (biological control) without causing harm to the environment. Slaughter and dressing operation and meat disposal can be carried without much environmental problems. The goat meat is more lean (low cholesterol) and relatively good for people who prefer low energy diet especially in

summer and sometimes goat meat (chevon) is preferred over mutton because of its "chew ability". Goat milk is easy to digest than cow milk because of small fat globules and is naturally homogenized. Goat milk is said to play a role in improving appetite and digestive efficiency. Goat milk is non allergic as compared to cow milk and it has anti-fungal and antibacterial properties and can be used for treating urogenital diseases of fungal origin. Goats are 2.5 times more economical than sheep on free range grazing under semi arid conditions. Goat creates employment to the rural poor besides effectively utilizing unpaid family labour. There is ample scope for establishing cottage industries based on goat meat and milk products and value addition to skin and fiber. Goat is termed as walking refrigerator for the storage of milk and can be milked number of times in a day.

- d) That, there is an immediate and urgent imperative now to motivate, encourage and attract the tribal people to take up Goatary farming in a more sustainable way.
  - e) Virtually every aspect of goat performance is controlled by genetics - milk, fat, protein, yield, reproduction, feed efficiency, length of life in the herd, calving ability and the ability to resist diseases- are all linked to unique genetic make -up. Thus the aim of the programme would be to have organized animal breeding services to cover this breed able population of Does & bucks by extending and institutionalizing door step Artificial insemination (AI) services so that the livestock can have faster genetic gain, on an economically sustainable basis.
3. The scheme has been formulated keeping the following objectives in mind.
- a) To develop Goatary Farming as an economic activity in Nilgiri Block area.
  - b) To encourage and increase stake holder investment participation in the whole value chain and production process of Goatary.
  - c) To encourage and facilitate sustainable models of production.
  - d) To encourage and mobilize farmers' stakes as partners in the same process such that a sense of ownership is instilled amongst the farming community leading to better ownership responsibility and accelerating the adoption of technology, financial discipline and quality control culminating in improved and sustainable economic returns.
  - e) To develop and strengthen the risk taking ability of the farming community through a combination of technology, assured markets, credit linkages and institutional support.
  - f) To enable the farming community to capture opportunities generated by the new climate of market oriented production and value chain approach.
  - g) Given the importance of genetics in the animals in the herd, it is important to manage genetic change and improvement. To provide Veterinary services and extension services for genetic improvement of the cattle for promotion of healthy and more productive animal.

With the intention of meeting the above aim and objectives, the ITDA, Nilgiri intends to invite proposals from interested, reputed and qualified organizations / Firms for supply of Goat (Does &

Bucks) and allied items to the tribal beneficiaries.

The EOI should be accompanied by a refundable EMD of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) for all bidder in the form of demand drafts drawn in favour of "The Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri". The ITDA, Nilgiri reserves the right to reject any /all applications without assigning any reasons thereof. ## 2. BROAD SCOPE OF WORK:

- i. Bidder's scope of work and supply shall comprise supply of Goat (Does & bucks) and allied items as per specification supported by a declaration certificate from a registered veterinary practitioner on genetic character of each Goat, breed, age.
- ii. To also support with detail health status, vaccination record, last calving date etc, duly certified by a registered Veterinary Practitioner.
- iii. The Goats to be supplied should have valid insurance cover for not less than 1 year on the date of supply.
- iv. Bidder should declare the number of goats available at their possession with detail history as mentioned in (i) above."

## 3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Bidder intending to bid shall fulfill the following eligibility criteria:

- a) Shall be an Institution / Firm / Farms / registered society etc..
- b) Should have proven financial services capability, particularly in financing programmes/ projects.
- c) Proof of Financial Status in the form of balance sheet/ITR

## 4. OUTPUTS: The selected Bidder is expected to:

- i. Propose a draft work-plan within 7 working days of the assignment in consultation with the Office of the PA, ITDA, Nilgiri. The draft work-plan should include the Plan of Action to undertake the assigned task for supply of goats to different location as specified.
- ii. Any other information deemed proper on the part of the Bidder.

## 5. BIDDING PROCEDURE:

- i. The Bidder qualifying the above criterion shall submit the bids in two separate sealed envelopes i.e. one for Technical Bid (Envelop - A (Annexure-II) & another for Financial bid (Envelop- B (Annexure-III)).
- ii. Sealed Envelope (A) would include Technical Bid and EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) along with detail declaration as per Annexure-II and also a brief history/background of their organization/Firm.
- iii. Sealed Envelope (B) would include the Price Bid as per Annexure-III
- iv. Both Envelope A and Envelope B must then be placed in one larger envelope(sealed) super

cribing "Supply of Goats & Allied Items for ITDA, Nilgiri, Dist - Balasore, State -Odisha, Pin - 756040)."

- v. Unsealed materials will not be accepted.'
- vi. Bids must be written in English.
- vii. Price should be quoted in Indian Rupee both in figure and in words
- viii. Any Bid received after the deadline for submission of Bid will be rejected outright and bidder will have to collect their bid document at their own expenses.
- ix. Bid will be opened on 22.12.2025 at 3.00 PM in presence of the Bidder and/or his/her authorized representative,

**6. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED WITH THE BID:**

- I. Expression of Interest (EOI) as per detail specification of Goats & Bucks at Annexure-I
- II. EMD in the form of Demand Draft.
- III. Organizational / history background of the Firm.
- IV. Infrastructure and other facilities available with the Firm/Farm/Institution including details of similar assignment done in the past and Financial Status (to be supported by document).
- V. Accreditation / quality certification (if any) of the Firm / Farm / Institution.
- VI. Authenticated copy of certificates of incorporation/registration and Memorandum of Association/Articles of Association/Trust Deed/Constitution of the organization.

The applicant in addition to furnishing complete information with the documents shall furnish a complete document on the proposed approach and work plan for rendering the services asked for.

Every sheet of EOI document and all forms / Annexure complete in all respect shall be signed by the person/persons duly authorized to sign on behalf of the applicants as a token of having understood and accepted all terms and conditions mentioned in EOI document. Any /all corrections made in the offer shall be duly authenticated by the signature of the authorized signatory.

**7. Period of Validity of Bids:**

- i. Validity of Bids shall be for a period of not less than 12 (twelve) months after the date of bid opening. A bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the ITDA, Nilgiri as non-responsive.
- ii. In exceptional circumstances, ITDA, Nilgiri may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. The Earnest Money provided shall also be suitably extended. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its Earnest Money. A Bidder granting the request will not be permitted to modify its bid condition.

**8. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**

- i. The Bidder shall furnish, as a part of its bid, Refundable Earnest Money of Rs. 10,000/- for all bidder.
- ii. The Earnest Money is required to protect the ITDA, Nilgiri against the risk of Bidder's conduct,

which would warrant the security's forfeiture.

- iii. The Earnest Money shall be in the form of Demand Draft pledged in favour of the PA, ITDA, Nilgiri,
- iv. Any bid not accompanied by Earnest Money will be rejected.
- v. Unsuccessful Bidder's Earnest Money will be discharged or returned as promptly as possible but not later than ninety (90) days.
- vi. The successful Bidder's Earnest Money will be released upon the Bidder signing the contract.
- vii. The Earnest Money may be forfeited:-
  - a. If a Bidder withdraws its bid during the period of bid validity specified by the Bidder on the Bid Form; or
  - b. In case of a successful Bidder, fails to sign the contract.

**9. Terms & Conditions:**

- i. The rates quoted should be valid for a period of at least 12 months from the date of opening of bids.
- ii. A health certificate from registered veterinary practitioner/competent authority should be enclosed for each animal.
- iii. Test report on Brucellosis should also be enclosed against each goat. Random test will be conducted at the spot to confirm Brucellosis free. Bidder will facilitate arrangement of feed and fodder supplies along with water at the delivery point till all test is completed/which may last for 2-3 days.
- iv. The Animals should be supplied at convenient intervals as required by the Agency and supply of animals should be affected as per work plan approved by the ITDA Office.
- v. All the laws related to transport etc. should be followed as per the guidelines of CPCSEA and Government of India.
- vi. The animals should be supplied tentatively at the following holding location: Nilgiri Block Cluster area to the SHG Members.
- vii. The animals will be quarantined and if any diseases animals are detected, the Supplier will remove such animals from the Agency premises at his own cost.

**10. Award Criteria:**

- i. The payment will be limited to the budget approved vide Letter No. 1209, dt. 24.10.2024 of Mission Director, Mukhyamantri Janajati Jeevika Mission (MMJJM).
- ii. The Financial bids for animals will be finalized based on the cost quoted per Goat (Including transportation price). The bids for supply of does & buck will be finalized based on the price per animal (Including transportation price).

11. ITDA, Nilgiri right to vary no. of animals at time of award: The ITDA, Nilgiri reserves the right at the time of contract award to increase or decrease the number of animals originally specified in the scheduled of requirements without any charge in unit price or other terms and conditions.

12. ITDA, Nilgiri Right to accept any Bid and to reject any or all Bids: The Procurement Committee

reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul bid process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or bidders of the grounds for the ITDA, Nilgiri action.

**13. Signing of Contract**

The supplier, on award of the contract should execute an agreement with ITDA, Nilgiri on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred) only at the expense of the supplier incorporating the terms and conditions.

**14. Security Money**

- i. Within seven (7) days of receipt of the Notification of contract award, the successful bidder shall furnish to the ITDA, Nilgiri the Security Deposit at the rate of 2% of the value of supply order.
- ii. The Security Deposit shall be in one of the following forms: (a) Bank Guarantee, issued by a reputable bank payable to Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri.
- iii. The proceeds of the Security Deposit shall be payable to the Office of the Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri as compensation for any loss resulting from the Supplier's failure to complete the obligations under the contract.
- iv. Failure of the successful Bidder (L<sub>1</sub>) to sign the contract and/or furnish the Security Deposit shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the Earnest Money, in which event the Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri may make the award to the next lowest evaluated Bidder (L<sub>2</sub>) or call for new bids.
- v. The Security Deposit will be released by the Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri and returned to the Supplier not later than 90 days following the date of completion of the Supplier's performance obligations under the contract.

**15. PENALTY CLAUSE**

For non-performance / delayed performance, the following penalties may be imposed on the successful bidder:

- (i) For feature of Security Deposit.
- (ii) Deduction of 2% of the value of supply order for each fortnight of delay.

**16. Resolution of Disputes**

- i. The Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri and the agency / Firm shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the contract, failing which either party may approach a competent court at Nilgiri having jurisdiction to resolve the dispute.

**17. Standards:**

The services provided under this contract shall conform to the standards mentioned in the Technical Specifications.

**18. Transportation:**

The transportation cost of Goat to be mentioned clearly as per FOR holding location mentioned in 9.vi.

**19. Payment:**

- i. No advance payment shall be made by the Department to the awardee.
- ii. 90% payment shall be released after the Provisional Acceptance Certificate (PAC) is received duly certified that the animals has been received in good condition as per the specification and balance 10% will be released on satisfaction of performance of each goat over a certain period of time.
- iii. For bids denominated in Indian Rupees, the payment shall be made through Cheque / Demand Draft / A/c of the bidder / Firms through off-line / online mode by the Agency.

**20. Taxes and Duties:**

The supplier entirely responsible for all taxes and duties etc. incurred until completion of the contract.

**21. Acceptance:**

Acceptance both provisional and final regarding the bid will be by the Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri.

**22. Amendment of EOI:**

At any time prior to the last date of receipt of bids Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri may for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the EOI document by an amendment. In order to provide prospective bidder reasonable time in which to take the amendment in to account in preparing their bids, the Project Administrator, ITDA, Nilgiri may as its discretion, extend the last date for receipt of bids and / or make other changes in the requirements set out in the invitation to EOI.
